4. Sample(s) of academic written work, preferably published. (10-25 pages in length).

5. Short description of graduate level courses that were taken at the Masters level in Development Studies together with related courses that are specific to the proposed area of specialization.

6. We will accept uploaded unofficial transcripts for evaluation purposes. Applicants must upload a grading scale/legend with their unofficial transcripts. Successful applicants will be required to submit official final transcripts.

7. Three (3) Recommendation Forms. All three (3) must be of an academic nature.

8. Official Proof of English Language Proficiency (if required).

Graduate Funding: All applicants accepted into the program on a full-time basis are considered for graduate funding from the Faculty of Graduate Studies and Research (FGSR).
